



Position: Landscape Maintenance Worker: Tree Care Technician

This is a **part-time seasonal** position through November 15th. The hours are greatest during the summer months. Some fall hours are available. **Compensation** is \$9 - \$13 an hour based on experience, qualifications, and certifications, i.e., CDL, Arborist, SC Applicator.

Flexible days and hours. You set your own schedule to complete the weekly landscape work at our sites.

Requirements:

- 18 years or older preferred
- A high school degree or equivalent preferred
- Must have a valid SC Drivers License
- Must be able to pass a criminal background test
- Must be able to pass a drug test
- Reliable transportation to work
- Experience hooking up and driving trailers
- Comfortable driving a truck and trailer with a 2500+ pound load

If you cannot drive a trailer, do not apply. A trailer test will be given to applicants before a position is offered.

Responsibilities: Watering trees and the care and maintenance of trees and TreesGreenville planting sites. This includes and is not limited to:

- Safely operate water trailer and refill water tank from fire hydrants
- The use of hand tools and power tools
- Weeding, mulching, raking, pruning, digging, planting, installing, fertilizing
- Edging, trimming, mowing
- Assisting with TreesGreenville's planting, mulching, and pruning events.

Required Skills:

- Must be a safe driver
- Must be able to perform manual labor outside in all weather conditions
- Must be able to work around ants, bees, thorns, pollens, poison ivy and oak, and environmental risks
- Must be able to lift up to 50 pounds on a routine basis
- Must be able to bend and stoop on a continual basis
- Ability to work quickly and efficiently
- Must comply with all tree planting and tree care standards
- Must comply with TreesGreenville's policies and procedures
- Must present yourself in a professional and appropriate manner
